



Tulip Craft

Supplies needed:

- Tulip flower pattern
- Paper straws/pipe cleaners/popsicle sticks
- Construction paper
- Scissors/hole punch
- Glue

1. Print off or draw a tulip pattern. Cut out your pattern and use it to trace your tulip flower onto colored construction paper. Then cut out your tulip flowers.

2. Accordion fold your flowers horizontally, folding them 4 times.

3. Next, Punch a hole in the center of the folded flower with your hole punch or scissors.

4. Unfold the tulip flower and fit your popsicle stick/straw/pipe cleaner in and out through the holes of the tulip.

5. Cut out two thin leaves from green construction paper. Add glue to the bottom of each leaf and wrap them around the bottom of the paper straw.

* If you are using pipe cleaners for your stems, you can take two green pipe cleaners and fold them into long ovals. Attach them to the bottom of your stem to create leaves.
